TIPS FOR SELF-TAPES

- 1. Frame the talent from head to toe. Start off with an introduction (slate) looking into the camera (more information on what we need for your slate are on the cover page below on page four)
- 2. Zoom in so that the talent is framed from the top of the head to the mid-chest area ONLY, and keep that frame for the whole audition. There should be little to no space over the top of the talents head. Be sure that the lighting is bright. Make sure that the sound quality is clear. It is very important that we can clearly see and hear you!
- 3. Now, do the scene(s)! (scene(s) are attached at the bottom of this audition package)
 - Make sure to have a reader (this person reads all the other lines that are not the lines of the role you're auditioning for)
 - DO NOT have the reader read aloud any of the stage directions. The reader only reads the lines for the other role(s).
 - Reminder to look natural, be energetic, have fun, and just be yourself!
 - Make sure the slate and the audition scenes are TWO SEPARATE videos
- 4. Feel free to tape the scene's as many times as you'd like, but only send us <u>one</u> take, the BEST take for the final submission.
- 5. Send forms, and self-tape in **ONE** email to: <u>dinodexcasting@gmail.com</u>
 - Audition videos should be sent via a link such as <u>YouTube or Vimeo</u>.
 - Please make sure to set the privacy settings so that the video(s) are UNLISTED.

EXT. DEX'S HOUSE - GARAGE

ANGLE ON: KEYPAD, Dex taps 2-3-5-5 (for d-i-n-o). The door starts to open revealing KAYLA, 9, surrounded by multiple ROCK ROLLING machines which are all on and making a lot of noise. Dex is wearing his backpack and holding Dana's backpack in his hand.

Kayla is also sporting a large WELDER'S MASK and weilding a SLEDGE HAMMER.

In mid swing:

START SC.1 _____ KAYLA Ahhhhhhh!

Kayla bashes the sledge hammer into a ROCK on the ground.

CLOSE ON: The rock, slightly cracked, the light from the opening garage door causes the rock to shimmer.

Kayla looks up to Dex, who tries to yell over the machines.

DEX I need your help!

Kayla lifts the welder's mask.

KAYLA You need what!?

DEX Your help!

KAYLA I thought that's what you said. I can't, I'm busy.

Kayla drops the mask and takes another swing at the rock.

KAYLA

АННННННН!

The rock remains unbroken.

Dex turns off the rock rolling machines, Kayla takes off her helmet.

KAYLA Hey, those need to roll for another 8 days.

DEX Seriously? DINO DEX - DD1001 - Pilot - First Draft - 15 Sept 2022 11.

Kayla opens one to reveal the beginning of some shiny GEMS, she tosses one to Dex.

KAYLA Gems don't shine themselves...

DEX I need your help with a dino experiment.

KAYLA I'm not that into dinosaurs.

DEX (mind blown) W-h-a-t?

KAYLA I like rocks better.

DEX But rocks are just... rocks.

KAYLA I'm going to pretend you didn't say that. Do you know that 'rock' in your hand is over 300 million years old.

DEX

Really?

KAYLA

Give or take a couple million years. Do you know what that's older than?

DEX

Dinosaurs?

KAYLA Now which is cooler?

Kayla flicks on the rock rolling machine, Dex immediately turns it off.

DEX Do you know that the dinosaur bones we find are just fossilized rocks? It's true, over time dino bones get covered in mud and dirt that hardens into rock. So, we're kind of interested in the same thing. DINO DEX - DD1001 - Pilot - First Draft - 15 Sept 2022 12.

Kayla is still unconvinced.

DEX Tell you what. I'll help you break that rock open if you help me solve my dino experiment.

Kayla considers the rock on the ground.

KAYLA What's your experiment?

Dex pulls his field guide out of his backpack and shows Kayla.

DEX Dino experiment 10-0-1, what did the T-Rex really look like. My theory is it had more fat than we think.

We push in on Kayla reading Dex's notes, as she does her eyes brighten.

KAYLA Paleoartists messed up... hah, I love when grownups get things wrong.

DEX

Me too.

A moment of connection.

KAYLA Personally, I'd rather see a fossilized rock T-Rex than a-

DEX

-Chubby-

KAYLA -Chubby one.

DEX I'm sure that's possible, my dino field guide let's you see all sort of things.

KAYLA (unsure) Really? DINO DEX - DD1001 - Pilot - First Draft - 15 Sept 2022 13.

DEX (assured) Really.

Dex's confidence confuses Kayla, she looks at the field guide a little closer.

ANGLE ON: The bones of the T-Rex beside the bones of the Chicken.

The SAND in one of the rolling machines SHUDDERS instantly drawing Kayla's attention.

We hear a <THUD> in the distance and the sand SHUDDERS again.

KAYLA What's doing that?

DEX Something big. Something really big.

The <THUDS> intensify until the BONES of a T-Rex walk and stop in the middle of the driveway.

We CUT TO the other side of the bones as the **BONE T-REX** turns and <ROARS> towards Kayla and Dex.

The camera pushes through the bones, through the gaping mouth to Kayla who can't believe what's she seeing.

DEX You sure you don't want to help me?

Kayla looks over to him, in complete amazement.

KAYLA (growing smile) Maybe I could get into dinos...

The Bone T-Rex starts to charge towards them.

KAYLA We're just imagining this, right?

Off Dex, still looking towards the T-Rex, in awe.


KAYLA RIGHT!?

EXT. SIDEWALK - DAY

Dex and Kayla in full Brachiosaurus costume stomp down the side walk before coming to a stop as Dex scans for the T-Rex.

Kayla takes the opportunity to stand and stretch.

START SC.2 -

Why do you like dinosaurs so much?

DEX Why do you like rocks so much?

KAYLA Because they're super ancient. Every rock you touch was at some point somewhere else in the universe. Our whole planet is made up of millions of rocky asteroids slamming into each other. Without rocks there would be no earth, no dinosaurs, no us. DINO DEX - DD1001 - Pilot - First Draft - 15 Sept 2022 19.

DEX (dumbfounded) Good answer.

KAYLA So why do you like dinosaurs?

Dex takes a deep breath, wanting to explain as well as Kayla did.

DEX

Because there's so much of their story that's left to be told. I remember the first time my sister Dana told me about dinosaurs and I just couldn't believe that there used to be these incredible creatures stomping around the planet who one day got wiped out by a huge-

KAYLA -Meteor, which is a giant rock by the way.

DEX

(smiling)
I just love that we can help figure
out their story by looking for
clues they left behind in the
ground and imagining what happened.
Without us doing dino experiments,
we'd never figure out who they were
and how they lived.

KAYLA (equally dumbfounded) Good answer.

A distant <ROAR> draws their attention towards the park.

DEX

Sounds like we found our T-Rex.

Another <ROAR>, this time closer.

KAYLA Or she found us!

As if on cue, the T-Rex bursts out from behind a house, its no longer just bones but is now covered in MUSCLE AND FAT.

DEX Muscle and fat T-Rex! DINO DEX - DD1001 - Pilot - First Draft - 15 Sept 2022 20.

KAYLA

Gross.

Dex turns to Kayla.

DEX (smiling) Science can be gross. It's one of the reasons I like being a scientist.

The M&F T-Rex charges towards them.

KAYLA (getting nervous) Well, your experiment is running right at us.

Dex turns back to the charging T-Rex.

DEX

Run!

Kayla reforms into Dex and the two take off with the T-Rex closing in fast.

KAYLA I don't think we're going to get away.

DEX We don't need to, we just need to get him into the park!

- END SC.2

Dex and Kayla turn a sharp corner, narrowly dodging a T-Rex chomp - that misses them but rips off the back of their costume's TAIL.

EXT. PARK - DAY
Dex and Kayla enter the nearly deserted park with the T-Rex
closing in on them.
DEX
On the count of three, you go left
and I'll go right. Beady? 1, 2Kayla doesn't wait for 5, she banks left, ripping their
costume in half just as the T-Rex bites at the now empty
space they both recently occupied.
Dex and Kayla fall to the ground and look up just as the T-Rex turns back towards them.
